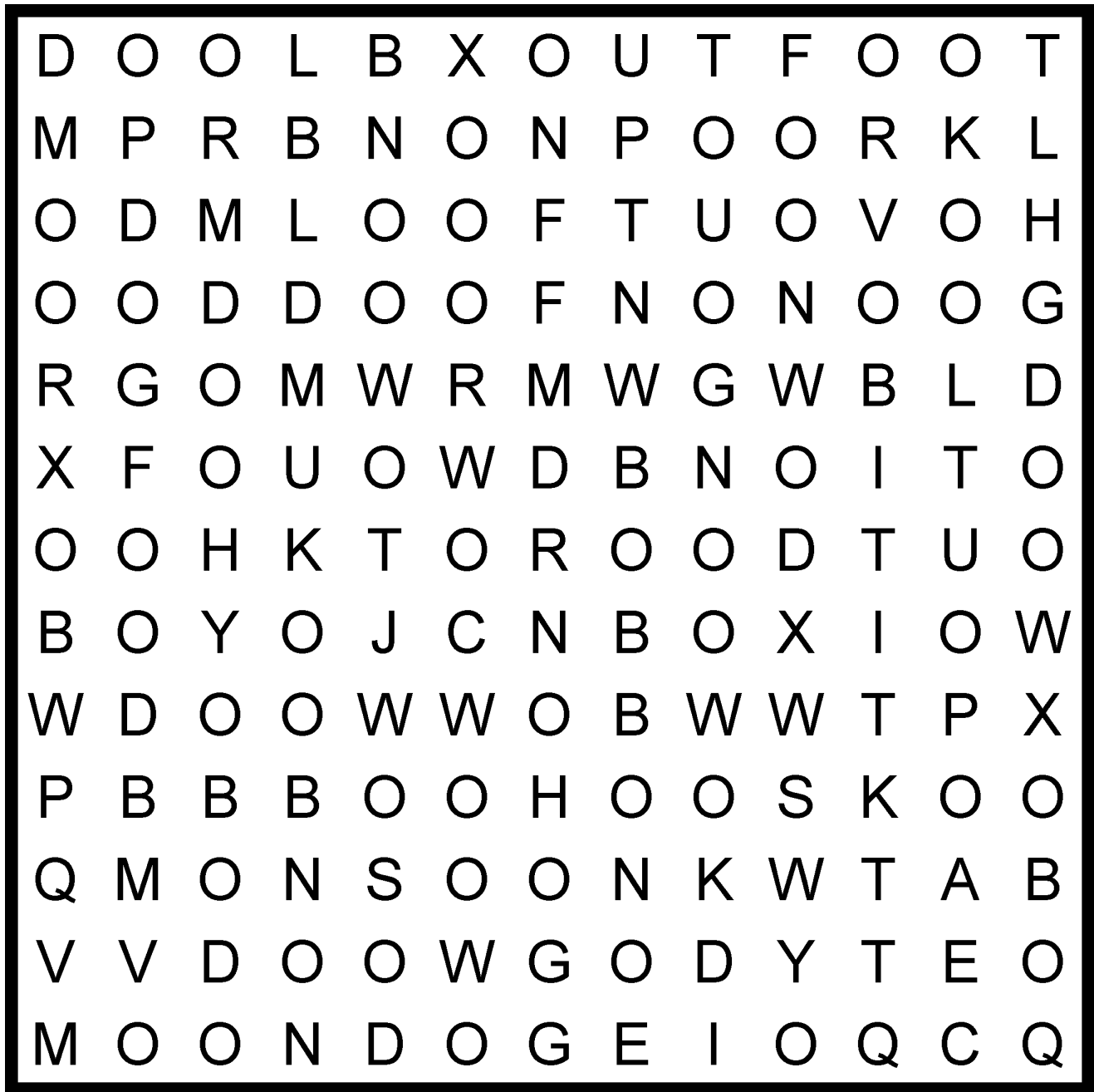


Double Agents

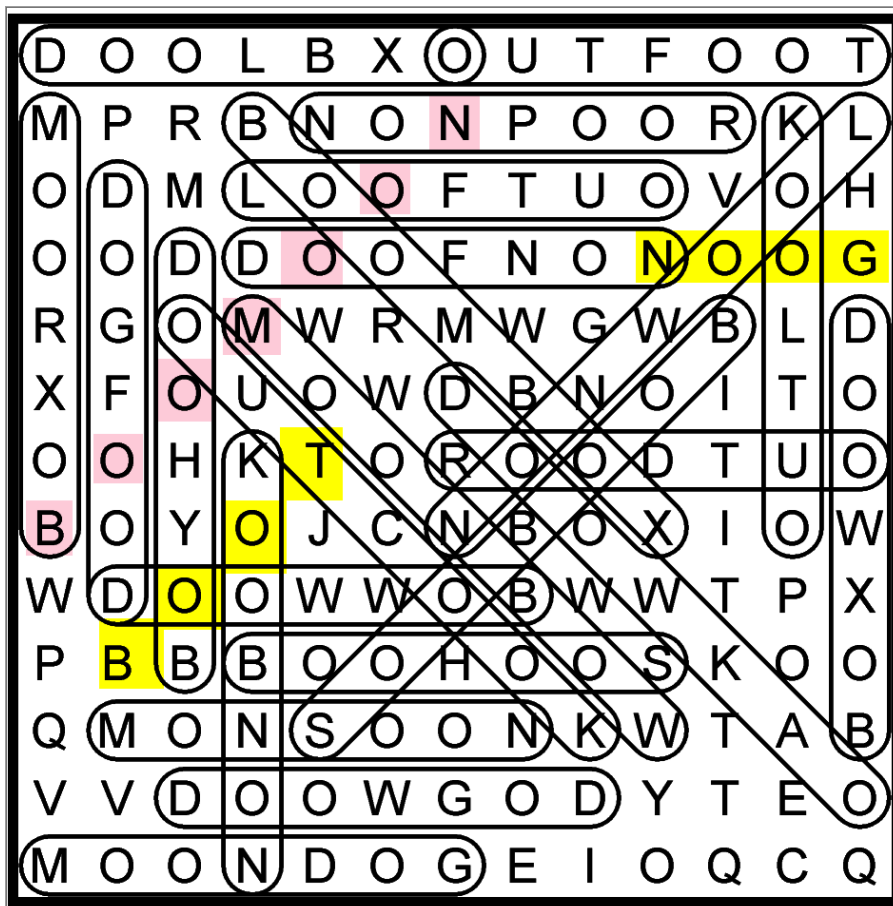
