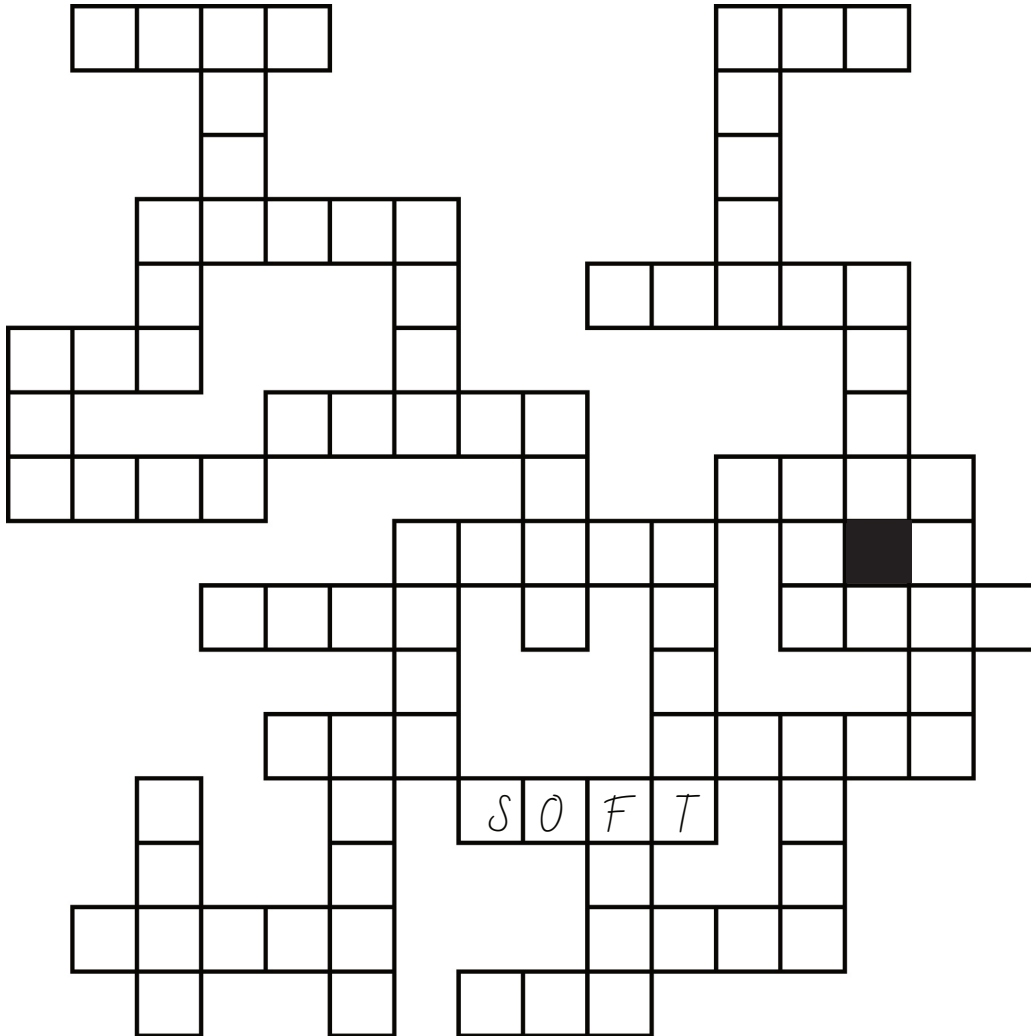


Antonyms
