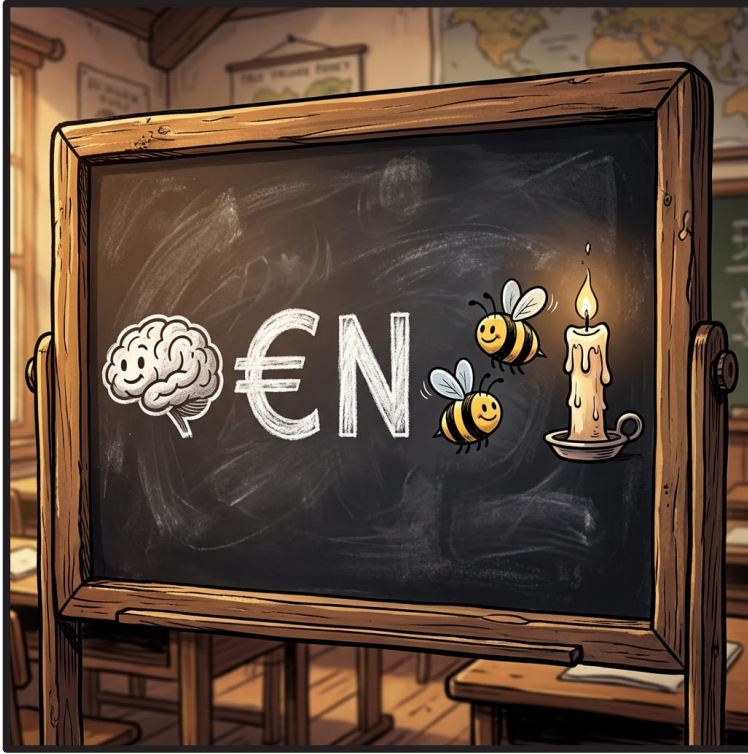


Rebus Picture Puzzles

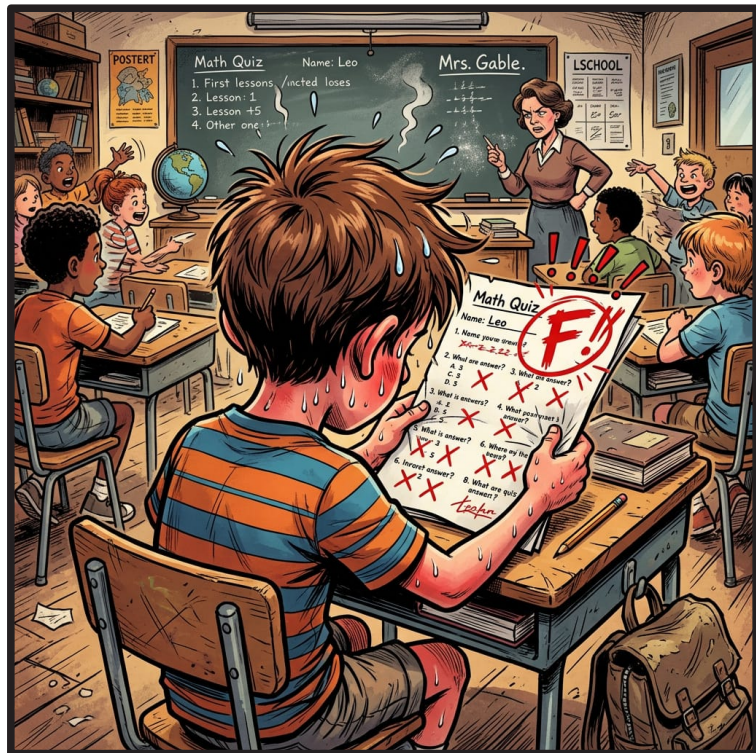
Rebus puzzles are picture puzzles that require you to sound out what you see, in order to say a common phrase. These are simple ones. Unless you don't know the phrases. LOL

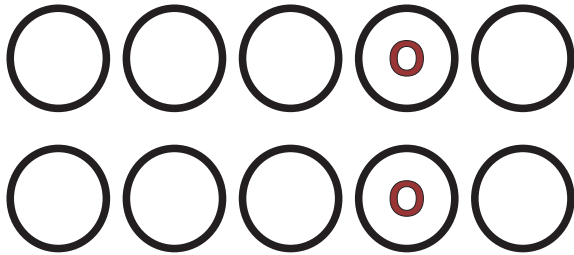

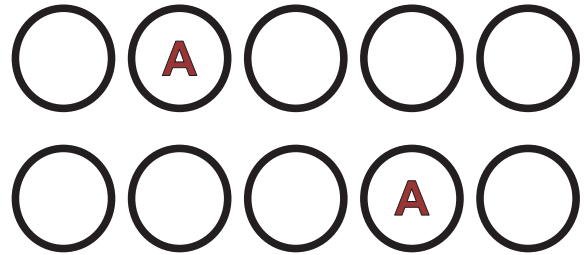
Food Anagrams

Find two sets of anagrams. All four **five-letter** words are related to food. The clues might help.

A. Fruit



B. Italian or Spanish dishes

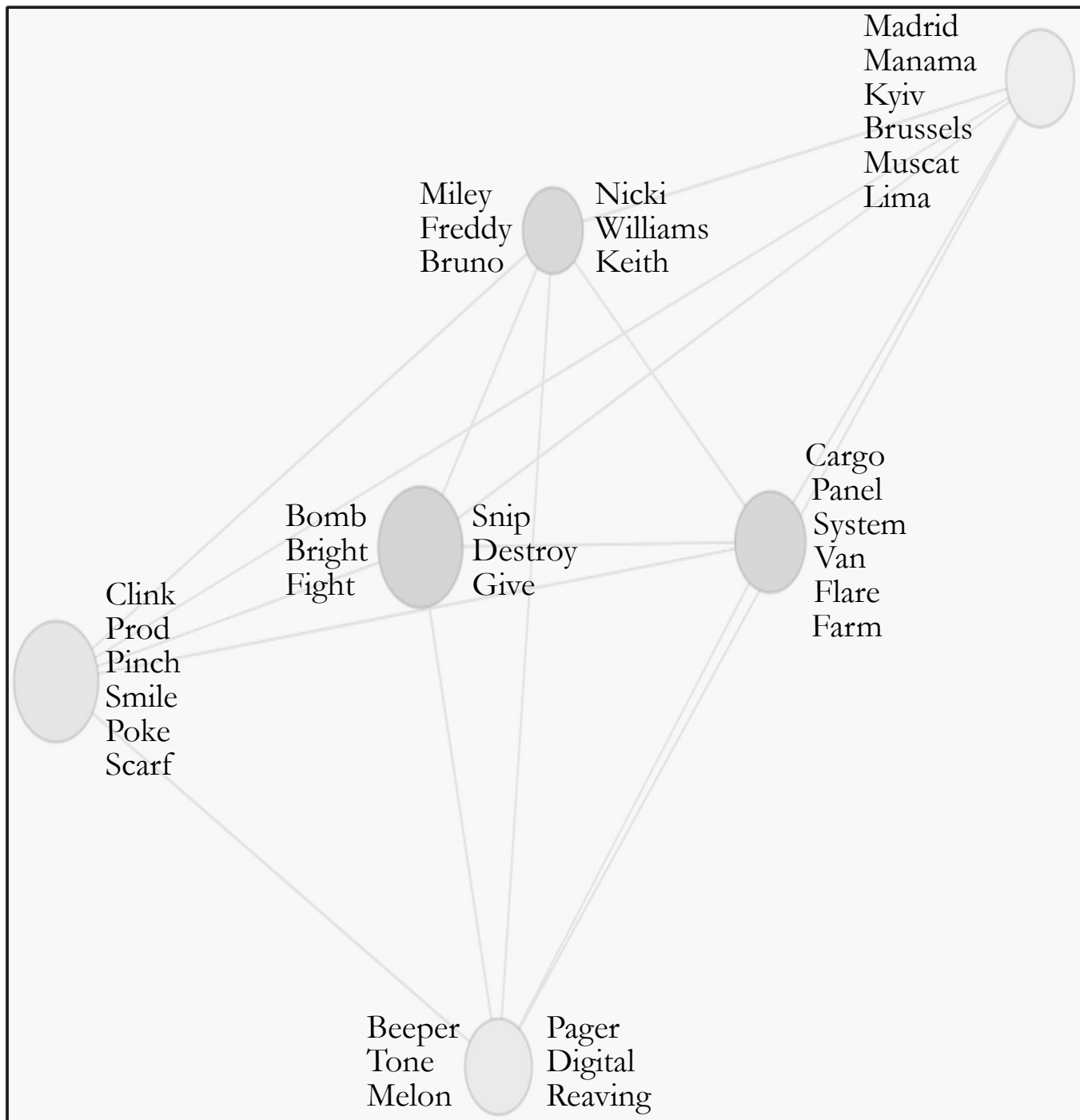


Bilateral Bonds

In each group of six words, find two that don't belong. The four remaining words will have **two** distinct characteristics in common. For example, "Apple" and "Pony" do not belong in the list: Strum, Apple, Drum, Hum, Pony, Thrum. The other four words rhyme and are related to sound production.

In each group, the two characteristics could be anything. Lateral thinking is encouraged.

Rebuses

- A. Mind your own beeswax (Euro plus N = *your own*)
- B. Low-grade fever

Food Anagrams

- A. MELON, LEMON
- B. PASTA, TAPAS

Bilateral Bonds

Clink, Prod, Pinch, Smile (~~Poke, Scarf~~)

1. Remove the first letter of each word
2. The remaining letters spell out units of length (link, rod, inch, mile)

Bomb, Destroy, Snip, Fight (~~Give, Blight~~)

1. Add **er** to the end of each word
2. The new words describe military terms

Pagers, Tone, Melon, Reaving (~~Beeper, Digital~~)

1. Find an anagram
2. The anagrams are all associated with *sour* (grapes, note, lemon, vinegar)

Panel, System, Flare, Farm (~~Cargo, Van~~)

1. Place the word *Solar* in front of each word
2. The results are all well-known phrases associated with the sun

Freddy, Bruno, Keith, Nicki (~~Williams, Miley~~)

1. Add a last name
2. The last name begins with the letter M (Freddy *Mercury*, Bruno *Mars*, Keith *Moon*, Nicki *Minaj*)

Manama, Kyiv, Muscat, Lima (~~Madrid, Brussels~~)

1. Recognize that each is a capital city
2. Country name has two syllables (Manama, *Bahrain*; Kyiv, *Ukraine*; Muscat, *Oman*; Lima, *Peru*)

Note: Bilateral Bonds is the type of puzzle that would make me tear my hair out to make. Also, it's kind of unfair to most puzzle lovers. On the plus side, I had fun finding red herrings to throw you off! I created this almost two years ago (2024) and never thought I would share it.
